We are very excited to see the commencement of this project’, said Ann Vaughan, Centre Manager HBNC. ‘This has been a vision in the pipeline since 2016 with a significant amount of community consultation, planning and fundraising. For a small community like Harrow, this project is not only very exciting but everyone realises how important it is to ensure the continued provision of safe and quality healthcare from babies to the elderly. In 2019, we received a major grant from the Collie Foundation and a generous bequest from the late Don Pyers to enable this vision to come to fruition. This project brings a smile across everyone’s faces in Harrow and beyond and the support has been invaluable’, she said.
